Please be advised that the City of Anamosa in their efforts to promote cleanliness and pride in the community has designated an on-site dumpster location for the removal of unwanted or nuisance related items from properties within the community for this program.

This program is intended for the residential customers within the corporate City limits of Anamosa. It is an opportunity for property owners and tenants to address non-compliance conditions.

All Anamosa residents shall bring their refuse & unwanted items to the central location as scheduled below. Residents must provide a valid form of identification and city water/sewer bill in order to place refuse items in dumpsters at the city lot located at 1210 WALWORTH AVENUE. City employees will assist in verification and direction of traffic. Crews will be on hand to assist residents for unloading purposes in order to decrease drop off time. Dumpsters will be provided during the hours listed on the following date: (Please note – all vehicles must be unloaded and out by the closing time posted above).

These times are tentative. Anyone dumping off materials after posted hours, will be fined.

VOLUNTEERS

If you do not have a way to get your unwanted items to the dump site and need volunteers to come pick them up for you – call City Hall at (319) 462-6055 and ask to be put on the list for pick up. Must call during normal business hours of 7:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday, April 22 through Friday, April 26.

There are many residents within the City of Anamosa who cannot bring or have the where-with-all to bring their items to the central location site at Walworth Avenue during the City Wide Clean Up. ITEMS ACCEPTED DURING THE PROGRAM

The City will accept junk, rubbish, odds & ends, furniture including sofas, rockers, recliners, mattresses, bicycles, bed springs, lawn mowers, swing sets, cabinets, old doors, screens, flooring and anything made up primarily of metal excluding appliances.

A limit of (4) passenger or light truck tires not over 20 inches and not mounted on rims will be accepted.

ITEMS WE CANNOT ACCEPT DURING THE PROGRAM

NO GARBAGE OR YARD WASTE (yard waste/brush & tree limbs can always be taken to the city brush pile by the Wastewater Plant). NO - TV's, VCR's, Computers, Radios, Batteries, construction and demolition materials (bricks, concrete, asphalt shingles, lumber, siding, dry wall) liquids (antifreeze, waste oil, paint – paint cans will be accepted if the lid is off and the contents are either dried or absorbed by saw dust, cat litter, etc.); hazardous materials (explosive materials, volatiles and flammables, poisons); any substance which may present a hazard to collection personnel and household materials that are normally taken under the current solid waste curb-side pickup program. Appliances will not be accepted during the cleanup.
